



PUBLIC CALL FOR HIRING VISITING TEACHERS, BRAZILIAN OR FOREIGN, THROUGH A SIMPLIFIED SELECTION PROCESS NOTICE N.° 11/2024-PROPESP/UFAM

The UNIVERSITY OF AMAZONAS FOUNDATION, via the OFFICE OF THE DEAN OF RESEARCH AND POST-GRADUATE STUDIES makes public, for the knowledge of interested parties, the simplified selection process for the hiring of visiting professors, Brazilian or foreign, to meet a temporary need of exceptional public interest. This event is governed by the following normative instruments: Law No. 8.745/93 and its amendments; Decree No. 6.975/2009; Decree No. 7.485/2011, updated by Decree No. 8.259/2014; MEC ordinance No. 243 of 03/03/11, published in the Official Federal Gazette on 04/03/11; Interministerial Ordinance No. 399, of 12/13/2016, published in the Official Federal Gazette on 12/13/2016; Law No. 12,772/2012 and its amendments; SRH – MP normative guidance No. 05 of 10/28/2009; Resolution No. 022/2021 – CONSEPE of 10/13/2021.

1. REGARDING THE POSITIONS

- **1.1.** This selection process is aimed at hiring **35 (thirty-five) visiting professors (Brazilian or foreign)** to work with the Post-graduate Programs of the Federal University of Amazonas, according to the specifications contained in Attachments I and II of this notification.
- **1.2.** Among the activities to be carried out are:
- **1.2.1.** Act as a support to the development and improvement of the post-graduate programs;
- **1.2.2.** Support the academic units in the improvement of their stricto sensu post-graduate programs (master's and PhD) and strategic institutional development projects;
- **1.2.3.** Contribute to the improvement of teaching, research and extension programs, as well as to the execution of teacher training programs;
- **1.2.4.** Enable the participation of high-level researchers and professionals in the teaching teams of the institution, aiming at the scientific, technological exchange and innovation to be developed in accordance with the legislation in force and the Institutional Development Plan IDP.

2. REGISTRATION

2.1. Period: 18/03/2024 - 29/03/2024.

2.2. Registrations will be exclusively via the institutional email of the post-graduate programs offering the vacancies according to Attachment II.

3. DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION

- 3.1. To register for the selection process, the interested party must present:
- I. Application form duly completed and addressed to the Coordinator of the Post-graduate Program offering the vacancy, which can be found in Attachment III of this notification.
- II. One copy of your curriculum vitae in digital format in (PDF format in single file), containing the list of qualifications, intellectual production and academic activities developed, accompanied by the appropriate evidence. For academic qualifications, copies of diplomas and/or certificates must be submitted.
- III. Individual work plan (IWP) of the activities to be developed in teaching and research with the corresponding Post-graduate Program. The IWP must be sent in a single Pdf file containing up to but no more than 30 pages.
- IV. Proof of payment of the registration fee via the payment slip, or proof of exemption for those who have had their request for exemption granted, in accordance with item 5 of this notification.
- 3.2. The information provided in the application form is the sole responsibility of the candidate, with the University of Amazonas Foundation having the right to exclude from the selection process those who fill it in with incorrect, incomplete or erased data, as well as if it is found, at any time, that the data provided is untrue. Under no circumstances will conditional applications be accepted.

4. REGISTRATION FEE AND INFORMATION FOR THE ISSUING OF THE PAYMENT SLIP

4.1. Registration fee: R\$200,00 (two hundred Brazilian Reais).





4.2. The payment of the registration fee must be made through the payment slip that can be generated via the site https://pagtesouro.tesouro.gov.br/portal-gru/#/emissao-gru. For filling in the payment slip, please use the following:

4.3. Once the application has been made, there will be no refund of the amount paid, except in the case of cancellation of the selection process.

5. EXEMPTION FROM THE REGISTRATION FEE

- 5.1. There will be no total or partial exemption from the payment of the registration fee, except for the Brazilian candidate who, cumulatively:
- **5.1.1.** Is registered in the Cadastro Único for social programs of the Federal Government CadÚnico, as per Decree No. 6.135, of 26/6/2007; and
- **5.1.2.** Is a member of a low-income family, as per Decree No. 6.135, of 2007.
- 5.2. An exemption from the payment of the registration fee will not be granted to candidates who do not have the Social Identification Number NIS already identified and confirmed in the CadÚnico database, on the date of their request.
- 5.3. The exemption from the registration fee may be requested in the period from 18/03/2024 to 20/03/2024 via the institutional emails of the post-graduate programs offering the vacancies, as found in Attachment II.
- 5.4. Applications for exemption without indication of the Social Identification Number NIS and, also, those that do not contain sufficient information for the correct identification of the candidate in the database of the CadÚnico will not be analyzed.
- 5.5. The Federal University of Amazonas will consult the CadÚnico database to verify the veracity of the information provided by the candidate.
- 5.6. A false declaration will subject the candidate to the penalties provided for by law, also applying the provisions of the single paragraph of Article 10 of Decree No. 83.936, of 06/09/1979.
- 5.7. The application for exemption from the registration fee of the candidate who omits or provides untrue information will be disregarded.
- 5.8. Requests for exemption from the registration fee will not be accepted via fax, postal mail, or if extemporaneous.
- 5.9. The foreign candidate who does not have a CPF number may submit the application for exemption from registration to the program in the period 18/03/2024 to 20/03/2024.
- 5.10. The request for exemption from the registration fee of the candidate who, simultaneously, has made the payment of the registration fee will be disregarded.
- 5.11. The list of candidates with exemption requests that have been granted will be made available on the webpage intended for the notification as of 25/03/2024.
- 5.12. The list of candidates with rejected exemption requests, accompanied by the motives, will be disclosed simultaneously with those requests that were granted, on the same webpage.
- 5.13. No appeal will be allowed against the rejection of the application for exemption from the registration fee. Any candidate who has their application rejected must perform the procedure provided in item 4 of this notification to effect their registration.

6. NECESSARY REQUIREMENTS

- 6.1. Be a holder of a doctor's degree for at least 2 (two) years;
- 6.2. Be a professor or researcher of recognized competence in their area of expertise;
- 6.3. Have relevant scientific production in the last 5 (five) years, counted starting from the date of registration backwards;





6.4. Have not been employed in the last twenty-four (24) months under the Law 8.745 of 09/12/1993.

7. WORKING CONDITIONS AND REMUNERATION:

- 7.1. The employee will be subject to the working period of **40** (**forty**) **hours per week**, without or with **exclusive service** as described in Attachment II.
- 7.2. The salary of the visiting professor will be established based on the qualification and experience of the candidate, observing the correspondence with the remuneration ranges of the Federal Teaching Careers and Positions Plan, Law No. 12,772 of 12/28/2012, plus the remuneration for the PhD (Attachment III of Law No. 12,772, of 12/28/2012) and food allowance of R\$658.00 (six hundred and fifty-eight Reais), which is set out in the following classes:
- 7.2.1. Class C (Adjunct)
- 7.2.2. Class C (Adjunct);
- **7.2.3.** Class D (Associate)
- **7.2.4.** Class E (Full).
- 7.3. The values of the salaries for each class that is specified in item 7.2 correspond to the following table:

- 7.4. The Brazilian or foreign visiting professor will be considered in the following classes:
- **7.4.1.** *C* (*Adjunct*) if they meet the requirements of qualification and experience equivalent to that of a permanent professor of the post-graduate program of the Federal University of Amazonas to which you will be linked;
- **7.4.2.** *D* (*Associate*) if they meet the qualification and experience requirements equivalent to that of a research productivity fellow of the National Council for Scientific and Technological Development, of the area of the post-graduate program to which the visiting professor will be linked, levels 2, 1C or 1D;
- **7.4.3.** *E* (*Full*) if they meet the qualification and experience requirements equivalent to that of a research productivity fellow of the National Council for Scientific and Technological Development, of the area of the post-graduate program to which the visiting professor will be linked, levels 1A and 1B;
- 7.5. The Coordination of the post-graduate course to which the visiting professor will be linked will have the responsibility, with the qualified approval of at least 75% (seventy-five percent) of its members, to classify the





selected candidates according to the classes described in item 7, of forwarding its opinion on the candidates to PROGESP for the necessary arrangements.

8. THE SELECTION PROCESS

- 8.1. The selection process will be carried out in strict compliance with Resolution No. 022/2021-CONSEPE, of 13/10/2021, available at the electronic address <u>Portarias e Normas (ufam.edu.br)</u> and <u>Deliberações (ufam.edu.br)</u> according to the schedule in Attachment IV (Schedule).
- 8.2. The selection process will consist of a single phase, of a classificatory and eliminatory nature, with the two evaluation items being:
- **8.2.1.** Analysis of the titles of the candidate's intellectual production and academic activities that are correlated to the area of knowledge and the CAPES area of the post-graduate program that requested the hiring of the professor. For the purpose of obtaining the score, when analyzing the titles, the scoring scales of Attachment V analysis of titles will be considered. The grades of the 3 items I Academic Qualification (NAQ), II Intellectual Production in the area of selection (NIP) and III Academic Activity (NAA) will be computed.
- **8.2.2.** Evaluation of the Individual Work Plan (according to criteria established in Attachment VI), taking into account its relationship with the activities of the post-graduate program and potential contribution to the strengthening of the post-graduate program.
- 8.3. The candidate who obtains a work plan score of less than 7 (seven) points will be considered disqualified.
- 8.4. The candidate who obtains a score of 0 (zero) in the for the items provided for in 8.2.1 will be disqualified.
- 9. The scores for items II Intellectual Production in the selection area and III Academic Activity (Attachment V), will be assigned as follows: If the highest number of points obtained in each of items II and III is less than 10 (ten points), the number of points obtained by each candidate is assigned as the score. If the highest number of points obtained in each of items II and III is greater than 10 (ten points), a score of 10 is assigned to the candidate who obtained the highest score in each of the items and, using the score and grade of that candidate as a reference, the other candidates are assigned a grade proportional to their respective score.
- **10.** The final result of the single phase will be made up of the arithmetic mean obtained via the sum of the scores of the analysis of the titles and the evaluation of the individual work plan:

FA: ((NAQ+NIP+NAA/3)+NIWP)/2

FA: Final Average

NAQ: Academic Qualification score NIP: Intellectual Production score NAA: Academic Activities score NIWP: Individual Work Plan score

11. In case of a tie, the following tiebreaker criteria will be used to classify the candidates, in the order presented as follows: I -the candidate with the highest NIWP, II - candidate with the highest NIP.

11. APPEAL PERIOD

The interested candidate will have up to 48 (forty-eight) hours to appeal against the final result to be published in the public notification, via the PROPESP (ufam.edu.br) intended for the notification on the PROPESP page.

12. APPROVAL OF THE FINAL RESULT AND THE EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT

- **12.1.** The candidate who achieves the highest score among those approved after the definitive homologation, carried out by the Chamber of Research and Post-graduate studies (CPPG) and the Teaching, Research and Extension Council (CONSEPE) of UFAM, will be summoned to present their documents.
- **12.2.** Additionally, the selected candidate will be summoned to sign the contract via the email stated in the registration form, which does not exempt the candidate from the responsibility of accompanying the publication of the final result of the selection process in the Official Federal Gazette. The list of documents necessary for the execution of the contract will be requested by the Department of Staff Development DPP PROGESP.





- **12.3.** Approved foreign visiting professors must submit a sworn translation of the PhD to the Department of Staff Development DDP/PROGESP/UFAM within a maximum period of 90 days, starting from the date of publication of the homologation of the final result in the Official Federal Gazette, so that it composes the documentation to be sent to the MTE Ministry of Labor and Employment, through the Immigration Management and Control System MIGRANTEWEB, for analysis of the application for work authorization by the General Immigration Coordination Department, the work authorization and subsequent signing of the contract being linked to the receipt of this document.
- **12.3.1.** In the case of a foreign visiting professor or Brazilian who is a non-resident in Brazil, whose PhD has been obtained abroad, the validation of the degree, required in Attachment I, will be certified by the coordination of the post-graduate course offering the vacancy, dispensing with the process of revalidation/recognition of the diploma in Brazil.
- **12.4.** The contract will have an initial term of:
- I 12 (twelve) months, extendable for up to 12 (twelve) months, for a visiting professor of Brazilian nationality; and
- II -24 (twenty-four) months, extendable for up to 24 (twenty-four) months, for a foreign visiting professor.
- **12.4.1.** The renewal of the contract will depend on approval related to a performance evaluation and institutional interest.
- **12.5.** The hiring, pursuant to Article 6 of Law No. 8,745/1993, of employees of the direct or indirect administration of the federation, the states, the Federal District and the municipalities, as well as employees of its subsidiaries, is prohibited.
- **12.6.** Candidates who have already been hired on the basis of Law No. 8,745/93, including as a Substitute or visiting professor by the Federal University of Amazonas or by any other Federal Institution of Higher Education, may not be hired again on the basis of this law, before 24 (twenty-four) months have elapsed, starting from the termination of their previous contract.
- **12.7.** The employee will carry out his activities with the post-graduate program applied to the selection process, for **40 hours a week with or without exclusive service as per Attachment II**, complying with the work plan presented at the time of registration.
- **12.7.1.** Foreign applicants who do not have a permanent visa or who have not obtained temporary or permanent residence because they come from one of the Mercosul countries, Bolivia or Chile (Arts. 4 and 5 of Decree No. 6.975/2009), will be requested, by the University of Amazonas Foundation, authorization for work via the Ministry of Labor and Employment and the respective concession under the condition of a temporary visa. The application fee for the work permit will be at the expense of the applicant. The foreigner must choose the country where he will receive the visa. After receiving the visa in the chosen country, the foreigner will have up to 15 days from his entry into Brazil to present it to the Department Staff Development of the Federal University of Amazonas. Only after said presentation will the foreigner be referred to the post-graduate program to which they applied for work via the selection process for the beginning of their activities.
- **12.7.2.** The foreigner admitted as a temporary worker, under contract, may only exercise activity with the entity by which he was hired, at the time of granting the visa, unless expressly authorized by the Ministry of Justice, after recommendations from the Ministry of Labor and Employment.
- **12.8.** The employee will be subject to the rules of accumulation of positions, jobs and functions provided for in the Federal Constitution, in the opinion GQ No. 145, of the Attorney General of the Union, of 30/03/1998, published in the Official Federal Gazette of 01/04/1998, and in the other regulations that govern the matter.

13. RESTRICTIONS AND TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT:

- **13.1.** The hired candidate will not be able to:
- I. Receive assignments, functions or responsibilities not provided for in the respective contract;
- II. Be appointed or designated, even if in a precarious capacity or as a substitute, to the exercise of a position in a commission or position of trust;
- III. Be rehired before twenty-four (24) months have elapsed from the termination of their previous contract.
- IV. Exercise professional activity for another public body, private company or individual, except for the one that has hired him at the time of granting the visa, unless expressly authorized by the Ministry of Justice, after recommendations by the Ministry of Labor (applies exclusively to foreign candidates with a temporary visa).
- **13.2.** The signed contract will expire:





- I. Automatically, at the end of the initial term, without the right to any compensation, except for the possibility of extension, observing the limit provided for in sub-item 10.3 of this notification;
- II. On the initiative of the employee;
- III. Termination or completion of the project, as defined by the issuer of the contract;
- IV. On the initiative of UFAM, if the employee does not present skills for the position. In such situations, disciplinary administrative proceedings will be instituted, granting him/her an ample right of defense.
- **13.2.1.** The termination of the contract, in the cases of items II and III, will be communicated at least thirty (30) days in advance. The termination of the contract, at the initiative of the Federal University of Amazonas, resulting from administrative convenience, will result in the payment to the employee of compensation corresponding to half of what would be due to him for the remainder of the contract.

14. FINAL PROVISIONS:

- **14.1.** A validity period of **1** (one) year is established for this selection process, as of the publication of its final result in the Official Federal Gazette, and may be extended, for the same period, at the discretion of the Administration.
- **14.2.** The resolutions of the Federal University of Amazonas that govern this simplified selection process, as well as the entire content of this notification, will be available for consultation and printing via the website PROPESP (ufam.edu.br).
- **14.3.** The present notification may be canceled or modified, in whole or in part, at any time, provided that supervening reasons so determine, without this generating rights or obligations in relation to the interested parties. In case of exclusion of a vacancy in which there is a registered candidate, UFAM will provide the necessary means for the affected candidate to request a refund of the amount paid for registration.
- **14.4.** The candidate must accompany the publications of any corrections and informative notes related to this notification on the PROPESP website https://propesp.ufam.edu.br/.
- **14.5.** All candidates who adhere to this notification are informed that requests for copies of written evidence requested by competing candidates may be granted, including with the respective corrections of the exam boards, when the requirements provided for in Law No. 12.527/2011 and in Decree No. 7.724/12 are met.
