And on the other hand, the Magnificent Rector, **Professor. Dr. Sylvio Mário Puga Ferreira**, Brazilian, University Professor, identified with Identity Card No. 0977440-8 - SSP/AM, CIC/MF no. 405.295.092-53, as **President of the Board of Directors of the FUA and also Rector of the Federal University of Amazonas**, on behalf and representation of the **FUNDAÇÃO UNIVERSIDADE DO AMAZONAS - FUA**, entity that sustains the Federal University of Amazonas - UFAM, with legal address at Av. Rodrigo Otávio, 6200 - Campus Universitário Senador Arthur Virgílio Filho - Centro Administrativo, Coroado I, registered with the CNPJ under no. 04.378.626/0001-97

Referred to below individually as a party and together as the parties, the parties agree, based on the mutual commitments herein, to enter into this Cooperation Agreement, in accordance with the following clauses:

FIRST. - OBJECTIVE. Establish actions aimed at stimulating and carrying out programs of scientific, academic, cultural, technical cooperation and institutional development around the conservation of the Amazon and the well-being of local communities, respecting the exclusive legal competence of the signatory parties.

This Agreement applies to all the respective units of the signatory parties, specific units being defined in eventual additive terms as necessary for future Work Plans.

SECOND. - OBLIGATIONS. The parties undertake, when mutually agreeable and according to their interests and needs, and respecting their available capacity, resources, and usual schedules, to:

- a) Exchange technical and scientific information regarding the objective of this Agreement;
- b) Exchange knowledge, services and products with a view to developing programs linked to the goals of this instrument;
- c) Develop research, extension activities, programs and events aimed at achieving the objectives of this agreement;



- d) Cooperate in the formation of knowledge networks that contribute to the conservation and well-being of Amazon communities;
- e) Cooperate in strengthening the capacities of researchers, teachers and students
- f) Mutual exchange of academic staff and administrative staff.

THIRD. - COOPERATION REGIME. The activities related to this Agreement will be executed through Work Plans, prepared by mutual agreement between the parties, in which the activities to be carried out, their characteristics and scope, the conditions of participation of each of the signatory institutions, objectives, tasks, responsibilities, management of intellectual property, terms and schedules, financial aspects and other relevant aspects. Such Work Plans will be approved and carried out in accordance with the internal rules and competencies of each of the parties.

FOURTH. -COORDINATION. To facilitate the development of the Agreement and ensure its correct execution, a Coordinator of each institution will be appointed, who will facilitate communication between the interested institutions and will provide the corresponding advice for carrying out and evaluating the proposed activities.

FIFTH – FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES. The eventual costs generated by this Agreement and any related WorkPlans must be previously agreed to in writing with regard to specific projects among the cooperating partners, through additions in each developed cooperation action. However, this Agreement does not create any immediate financial commitment for any of the parties. Neither party has the authority to impose any financial liabilities or commitments on the other party without that party's prior written consent.



SIXTH. - VALIDITY AND EXTENSION. This Agreement shall be in force for a period of five (5) years, from the date of the second signature. The parties may extend this Agreement by mutual written agreement. If either of the two institutions considers it necessary to terminate this Agreement at any time, it may do so with prior written communication, sent at least three (3) months in advance. Notwithstanding, and regardless of the reason for its termination, the programs, projects and activities that are being carried out under this Agreement will either continue until the approved termination date or the parties will work together in good faith to establish a plan for winding up ongoing activities.

SEVENTH. – MODIFICATIONS. This Agreement may be modified by mutual agreement between the parties, at the request of any of them with prior written communication and thirty (30) business days notice in advance. To be valid, the changes will have to be approved by both parties.

EIGHTH. – RESOLUTION OF DIFFERENCES. Any difference resulting from the interpretation and/or application of the clauses of this agreement and the specific Work Plans that are created under it, will be resolved by mutual agreement by the parties through direct negotiation.

NINTH. – INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY. The Work Plans, referred to in the third clause, will contain the clauses that define the ownership of any intellectual property created in the course of the activity.

TENTH.- EXCLUSION OF THE LABOR RELATIONSHIP. In all the actions derived from this Agreement and from the subsequent Work Plans, the parties agree that the personnel of each institution are and shall remain the employee of that individual's home institution only and are under the direct control of that institution regardless of whether it is providing other services outside of it, or in the facilities of the institution to which it was commissioned. In no case will an employee of one institution be considered the employee of the other institution or will the parties be considered a joint employer of any.

If, in carrying out an action of the Agreement, a party contracts with an outside contractor or vendor to perform work, such a third party shall be an independent contractor of the party that hired them and, shall not create or be construed as creating an employment relationship of any nature, with the signatory institutions.

ELEVENTH.- ASSIGNMENT. The parties may not partially or fully assign the execution of this Agreement to a third party, except with prior express and written authorization from the parties.

TWELFTH.- EXECUTION IN GOOD FAITH. The parties declare that this Agreement is the product of good faith, for which reason they will carry out all possible actions for its due compliance.



THIRTEENTH.- ON THE FINAL PROVISIONS. The parties declare that this cooperation instrument establishes the complete and exclusive manifestation of the agreement between them.

As proof of the agreement, this Agreement is signed, in four (4) originals: two (2) copies in Portuguese and two (2) copies in English, of equal tenor and value.

<p>Project's Justification. <i>Justify the project's implementation, its academic relevance, the reach and the benefits of its results (quantifying, if possible) for UFAM and/or community etc.</i></p> <p>The Andes Amazon Program of the Chicago Field Museum has been carrying out research aimed at contributing to conservation and people's well-being in the Amazon for over 20 years, among others through the development of Rapid Biological and Social Inventories. Their work is highly collaborative, involving local partners in the countries where they have worked at different scales. In 2021 they started working in the Brazilian Amazon. Given the importance of the university's presence in the upper Solimoes region, as a public higher education institution, for the formation of professionals from the region, including indigenous people, peasants, riverbank communities, and considering also its lead participation in socio ecological and interdisciplinary research, the Field Museum considered this institution to be a key partner for carrying out research in the Brazilian Amazon.</p>		
<p>Methods</p> <p>Our work will be carried out using qualitative and quantitative research methods, including focus groups, interviews, participant observation, from the local (with communities), to the regional and the national levels (governmental, non-governmental and civil society organizations). The more precise methodological design for the selected study sites is part of the work plan of this agreement.</p>

Expected Results (describe briefly)

The agreement will allow both institutions to work together around the design and development of a Rapid Inventory in the Brazilian Amazon. This collaboration will produce information and recommendations about the social and ecological situation of the selected study sites, which will be relevant for decision makers in order to promote conservation and people's well-being. Also, this collaboration will contribute to capacity-building of UFAM students, local communities and institutions.
